Dear Parent/Guardian and Senior Student:

We have finalized the location for our 2021 **Project Graduation Celebration**. As you may know, this event was established to prevent accidents caused by alcohol or chemical abuse. We are asking for your support for its continued success.

The graduates will gather at PHS to board the busses at approximately 8:30 (exact time TBD). Once at the facility, we will begin the evening with a Comedy Hypnotist. Activities currently include volleyball, basketball, soccer, swimming, ping pong, roller skating, ice skating, air hockey, foosball, arcade games and billiards. Other entertainment provided will include karaoke, DJ, and a photo booth. Attendants will also receive a T-shirt designed by one of their peers. There will be a constant supply of food and drinks throughout the evening and a continental breakfast will be provided. Students will return to PHS around 5:30 AM.

It is our intent to have as many seniors as possible attend Project Graduation. Because this event costs about **\$125 per student** we ask the community to help reduce the individual burden but are never certain how much we will receive from these requests. **At this time, we are asking that parent/guardian and senior students complete the attached contract and return it with the amount that you would like to contribute toward the cost of the event (minimum payment of \$60) ASAP.** This will cover all of the expenses for the evening, including the use of the facility, food, entertainment, and transportation. If there are circumstances in which the **required minimum is not affordable, please contact the school nurse.** She will ensure that payment need not be made and your situation will remain confidential.
